

Rules for Rollovers 2011-12

Fremont Youth Rodeo Series and Purina Saddle Series

1. A contestant can decide to “rollover” their time from one contest to another if the pattern and ground conditions are the same. An example would be, a person can rollover their barrel or pole time from “**Fremont Youth Rodeo**” on Saturday afternoon to “**Purina Saddle Series**”, Saturday night or Sunday morning competitions or both.
2. The person will need to make the decision before the competition starts and entry fees for all contests will need to be paid before the first run takes place.
3. This release form will be signed by the contestant for agreeing to “Rollover” rules.
4. Rolled over times, only will be used if the same arena is used for both days of competition and the barrels are staked with the same measurements, and stakes are left in the ground.
5. Open, Youth or Poles times can be rolled over only forward and not backwards to another event.
6. If conditions and/or arena are changed between Saturday and Sunday runs, your entry fee will be refunded, and there will be no rollover, awarded at the discretion of show management.
7. Rollover times and names will be announced before the start of each competition.
8. Once your entry fees are paid, there will be NO refunds.
